Scholarship Guidelines

The Connie Baird Memorial Scholarship was established and endowed to honor the memory of Connie Baird, coalition founder, past president, and inspirational leader. In recognition of her role as a peer reviewer for the National Cancer Institute, her years of service to the medical field as well as her strong belief in the positive impact of science upon our future, the scholarship is offered to graduating seniors planning to pursue a career in the field of science. (Research or Applied)

One or two scholarships may be awarded in the amount of \$500-\$1000 based on the following criteria:

- Applicant is a graduating senior, residing in Islip Township;
- Two Letters of recommendation are submitted. One must be from a science teacher;
- Copy of the applicant's official transcript; (please include senior year first semester grades as well as SAT/AP information);
- Proof of acceptance in an educational program at a two year or four year college or a university for the 2017-2018 academic year;
- List or resume of extra curricular activities, volunteer work (and employment);
- Essay (extremely important)
- Completed, on time, scholarship application <u>April 16, 2018</u>
 Must be mailed via U.S. Post Office. No FedEx, UPS or other carriers.

These scholarship(s) are not need-based and may be awarded to anyone who applies, based solely upon the decision of the Board of Directors of the Connie Baird Memorial Scholarship. Following a review of the applications, the Board of Directors will determine the scholarship winner(s).

Please return the application along with the other requested criteria, postmarked no later than April 16, 2018. No late or incomplete applications will be considered.
