To Whom It May Concern:

Enclosed are applications and guidelines for the LI2Day Scholarship and the Maria A. Sciara Scholarship. Both scholarships are administered by LI2DAY. **Please pay careful attention to our eligibility requirements for each scholarship before distributing to your students.** Be certain that students receive a copy of the appropriate Application Guidelines with the Scholarship Application.

Eligibility requirements are as follows.

LI2Day: This is a \$2,500 scholarship that will be awarded to 5 graduating seniors in Nassau and Suffolk Counties. LI2Day has awarded OVER \$200,000 in scholarships to Long Island students in the past 14 years. The student must reside with a parent or guardian who is a survivor of **breast cancer and/or other women's cancers**, or have resided with a parent or guardian who has passed from **breast cancer and/or other women's cancers**.

Maria A. Sciara : Those aspiring to become teachers will be given extra consideration for this scholarship.

This is a \$2,000 scholarship that will be awarded to 3 graduating seniors in Nassau and Suffolk Counties. \$6,000 has been earmarked for three (3) scholarships. The student must reside or have resided with a parent or guardian who is a survivor of any cancer **other than breast cancer and/or other women's cancers** or have resided with a parent or guardian who has passed from any cancer **other than breast cancer and/or other women's cancers**.

Applicants for either scholarship must also reside in Nassau or Suffolk County.

- The application and all accompanying materials must be submitted together in a single package. No incomplete applications will be considered.
- The due date for both applications is April 2, 2018. There will be no exceptions. Please be certain you give your students enough time to respond in a timely manner.
